MOXI's mission is to ignite learning through interactive, play-based STEAM experiences. Located in Santa Barbara, the museum offers three floors of engaging exhibits, including an Innovation Workshop makerspace. MOXI provides educational programs for all ages, from toddlers to adults, with a core belief that curiosity is best sparked through active, joyful learning.

Accessibility and community outreach are central to MOXI's approach. In the past year, the museum has hosted over 11,000 students on reduced- or no-cost field trips, with 73% from Title I schools. They have offered \$1 tickets to over 8,400 EBT cardholders through the Museums for All program and provided Community Partner Memberships to nearly 2,000 visitors from local organizations like CADA, Santa Barbara County libraries, San Marcos High School Transition Program, among many others. Through these efforts, MOXI continues to make joyful, interactive learning accessible to families throughout the region.
